Primary Election Ballot Choices

There will be 3 ballot choices in the Primary Election, each voter may vote ONE:

Alaskan Independence-Democrat-Libertarian Candidate	All candidates except Republican (Any voter may vote this
Republican Candidate w/ballot measures	Republican candidates only (Voters registered as Republican, Non-Partisan, or Undeclared at least 30 days before the election may vote this ballot)
Measures Only	No candidates— only ballot measures (Any voter may vote this ballot)

US Representative	State House (All 40 districts)

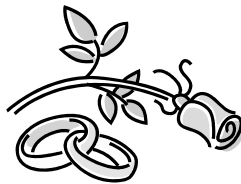

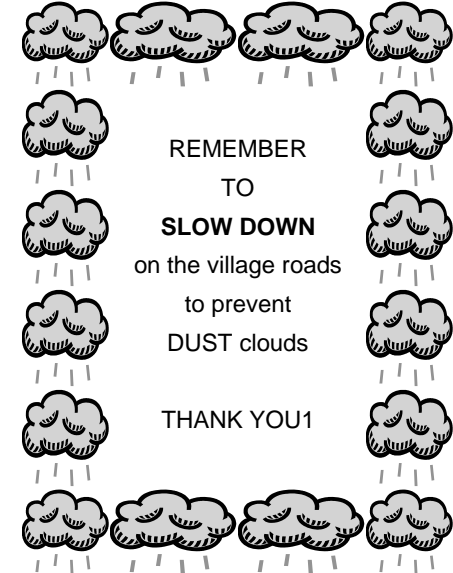
