SPRAASNIKAM—SNUIKUUTEM

In Port Graham, all over Alaska and other communities around world with Russian Orthodox religion influences, the Julian calendar is still used for important celebrations and holidays. The Julian calendar is 13 days later than the Gregorian calendar that we use in our everyday lives. In history the Julian calendar was 11 minutes and 14 seconds longer than the solar year. By 1580 A.D. there were 10 extra days that accumulated, Pope Gregory from the church dropped 10 days from October 1580 to make the calendar year correspond more closely to the solar year. He also ordered that each fourth year would be a leap year adding an extra day in February.

Folks in Port Graham acknowledge the western holiday New Year which is celebrated on the 1st of January, but our real traditional celebration of New Years is on the 14th of January. To celebrate our Traditional New Years a play called Snui-

kuutem is performed.
Snuikuutem is RussianSlavonic word which
means "New Year". This
traditional native play has
been passed down from
our ancestors from generation to generation. If
you're in Port Graham
during the New Years festivities you don't want to
miss seeing the tradition
that still lives here in Port
Graham.

Slow down and look when coming to an area known to be popular of kid activities.





One of our staff announces "the mail is ready" on the C.B. when mail is ready to be picked up.


