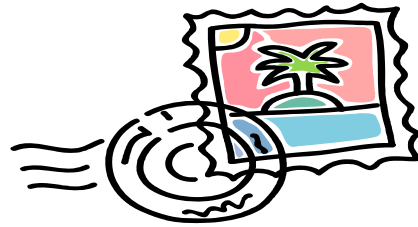


SPEED LIMIT

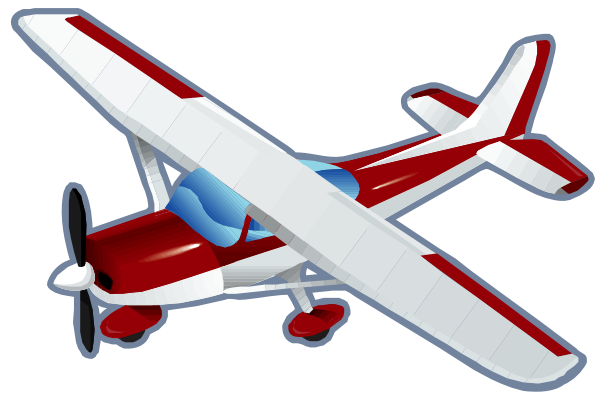
